I'm writing to inform you that the Beaufort County School District (BCSD) has implemented a district-wide safety initiative that includes the use of weapons detection systems at all high schools.

Beginning this week, all spectators—including home and visiting fans—will be screened upon entry to athletic events using the CEIA OPENGATE weapons detection system. This technology is designed to help prevent weapons from entering our campuses and to support staff in identifying attempts to bring prohibited items into school or event venues. The system is focused on detecting weapons of mass casualty, such as firearms, while allowing common personal items like phones, keys, and wallets to pass through without delay.

We ask that parents, students, and visiting teams share this information with anyone planning to attend upcoming games. Your patience and cooperation are greatly appreciated as we work to ensure a safe environment for all athletes, spectators, and staff.
